The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in special session, Monday, March 28, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of March 21, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk/Washington County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. The Board discussed the possibility of transferring additional funds to be used specifically to purchase rock.

Met with Hornback, CPC/General Assistance, regarding monthly Community Services update.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the resolution for the quarterly interfund operating transfer from Rural Services Fund (0011) to Secondary Road Fund (0020) in the amount of \$250,000 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Abrahamson regarding Garden Club update. Sigourney FFA will take over the rent-a-pot program in 2012.

Various board and committee reports were held. Hadley attended Public Health, ISAC and Veterans' Affairs meetings. Wood attended ISAC and Veterans' Affairs meetings. Berg attended Veterans' Affairs and legislative meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Lynn Reasor sent an email requesting to be reinstated as a Keokuk County Death Scene Investigator. Board consensus was unanimous to allow said request.
