

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
APRIL 11, 2011

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in special session, Monday, April 11, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Presentation of proposal by Mark Ales to acquire Keokuk County Certificate of Purchase at Tax Sale #2004149 was postponed until later in the meeting.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the Keokuk County Courthouse Grounds Application for JEL director and students to promote tobacco awareness with date and liability insurance to be provided at a later date. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk/Washington County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. The pavement patching contract has been received. Additional patching and traffic control was added to the contract as previously discussed.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a utility permit application with Wapello Rural Water Association as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a variance for an entrance widening request in the 10000 Block of 300th Street (Section 18, Township 74 North, Range 13 West) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a variance for a new entrance request in the 17000 Block of 185th Avenue (Section 9, Township 76 North, Range 12 West) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the low bid of Ohalloran in the amount of \$70,882 for a 2011 International single axle dump truck. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the minutes of April 4, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Presentation of proposal by Mark Ales to acquire Keokuk County Certificate of Purchase at Tax Sale #2004149 was held. Board consensus was to proceed forward on this matter.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the quarterly report of fees collected by the County Auditor and Sheriff, and monthly report of fees collected by the County Recorder and Clerk of Court as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS/Ollie sewer and RUSS/Harper lagoon meetings. Hadley attended E911, Veterans' Affairs and RUSS/Ollie sewer meetings. Berg attended Decat and Nurturing Families meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was not held due to no additional topics to discuss.

Further review and reconsideration of Keokuk County Engineer vacancy candidates and offer was held. Consensus was to call applicant #6 and set an interview for April 12, 2011 at 5:30 p.m.

Keokuk County Courthouse Electrical Project update was held.
