

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
APRIL 18, 2011

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 18, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a proposal that Keokuk County compromise and assign Certificate of Purchase at Tax Sale designated #2004149 pertaining to Lots 5 and 6 of Block 7 of the Original Plat of the City of Ollie in Keokuk County, Iowa, to Mark Alan Ales in exchange for the payment of \$2,500 plus \$100 transfer fee and publication costs in full and complete satisfaction of any and all outstanding unpaid property tax, special assessment, penalty, interest and costs thereon and to set a public hearing for Monday, May 9, 2011 at 8:35 a.m. in the Board Room, First Floor of the Courthouse. All ayes and motion carried.

Discussion and consideration of employment package ranges for Keokuk County Engineer – alternative arrangements was held. No formal action was taken at this time.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the resolution pertaining to county driveway installations as submitted changing financial responsibility from the County to the requestor with an effective date of April 18, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the Personnel Report for David Brooks (temporary/seasonal) as of April 18, 2011 at \$11.00 per hour as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a Memorandum of Understanding for Construction Inspection Services between the Keokuk County Board of Supervisors and the Keokuk County Conservation Board for the construction of concrete pavement at Lake Belva Deer County Park as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of April 11, 2011 and April 12, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the claim listing dated April 18, 2011 with the exception of the Alliant Energy \$2.89 penalty for Emergency Management. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the Personnel Report for Jesse Sanders, from Reserve Officer at \$12.00 per hour to Deputy Sheriff with a salary of \$43,363.20 effective April 4, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a RUSS meeting. Berg and Hadley attended the Endowment meeting.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Mark Cavin entered to inform the deepest holes have been filled on his road, but more rock is needed. Board consensus was to allow the purchase of portable radios for medical examiner investigators and for Derek's Lawn Service to continue mowing the DHS lawn. Discussion of the Sanitarian's job description and budget was held.
