

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS**  
**APRIL 25, 2011**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in special session, Monday, April 25, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to post immediately the position of Assistant County Engineer with an annual salary of \$60,000 to \$65,000 with the requirement of a P.E. (professional engineer) license or to acquire within 18 months of employment with the application deadline as May 6, 2011 to be posted outside of the Keokuk County Supervisor's Board Room for 10 days. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk/Washington County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve a utility permit application – Windstream Communications – 305<sup>th</sup> Ave in Clear Creek Twp, T75N, R10W, Section 33 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve Calhoun-Burns proposal of \$19,000 for bridge inspection program manager services for 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of April 18, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Veterans' Affairs Director, regarding IDVA grant.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the Personnel Report for Elmer D. Harms, temporary custodian, at \$10.00 hour effective April 18, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve Fireworks Permit #52 for Craig Frederick for display on May 29, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with CPC/General Assistance regarding March monthly Community Services update. The Governor signed SF 209 which repeals SF69 regarding CPC process and function for counties and discussed projected adverse affects thereof.

Various board and committee reports were held. Hadley attended RHTF, SADC and Semco meetings. Berg attended Empowerment and Washington County Board of Supervisor meetings last week. Wood had no meetings to attend although he helped move items to the East Yards for the County sale and loaded filing cabinets for DHS.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. An ad will be placed in the Keokuk County Chief that announces the closing of the Courthouse on May 13, 2011 due to the new electrical switch over.

On vote and motion the meeting adjourned at 11:05 a.m.
