

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS**  
**MAY 23, 2011**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in special session, Monday, May 23, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Berg and Hadley. Absent was Wood.

Hadley moved, Berg seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Berg seconded approval of endorsement without recourse of Iowa State warrant to GeoSource for Ollie site in sum of \$1,820 for underground storage tank rehabilitation as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Decisions regarding employment of Assistant Keokuk County Engineer and terms and conditions of employment with respect thereto was held. Hadley moved, Berg seconded to make a conditional offer of employment subject to pre-employment testing. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk/Washington County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department.

Hadley moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of May 16, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Berg moved, Hadley seconded to acknowledge the Personnel Report for the hire of Bradley Luers, Conservation Aide (temporary/seasonal), Conservation Department at \$9.50 per hour effective May 23, 2011 with a wage change to \$9.75 effective July 1, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Hornback, CPC/General Assistance, regarding monthly Community Services update. Jesse also discussed MHDD legislative issues.

Various board and committee reports were held. Hadley attended SADC, Emergency Management, Semco and RHTF meetings. Berg attended an Empowerment meeting last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Fifth District Legislative meeting will be held in Ottumwa on June 8, 2011 at the Bridgeview Center.

Conference call with NACO was held to explain programs, policies, and educational webinars available to members.

On vote and motion the meeting adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
