

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS**  
**JUNE 6, 2011**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 6, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of May 31, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to nominate Jeff Shipley, Sheriff, for Public Safety Officer Medal of Valor and Law Enforcement Congressional Badge of Bravery. All ayes and motion carried. Sheriff Shipley was present to inform he was nominating Sgt. Eric Stein and Chief Deputy Casey Hinnah for the above honors.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the Assistant Keokuk County Engineer agreement as submitted subject to completion of pre-employment requirements. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk/Washington County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. The Richland Mayor is asking for clarification regarding ownership of Main Street in Richland, Iowa due to transfer of jurisdiction. Time is approaching to purchase a motor grader. County records indicate Cat is a far better machine with good trade-in value and less cost to operate.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the claim listing dated June 6, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the resolution regarding the quarterly interfund operating transfer from Rural Services Fund (0011) to Secondary Road Fund (0020) in the amount of \$250,000 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Review and possible approval of FY 2012 salary certifications was held. A formal decision will be made at a later date.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a Pathfinders meeting. Berg attended a mental health/intellectual disabilities redesign meeting in Mount Pleasant. Hadley had no meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Lynn Reasor, Medical Examiner Investigator sent an email requesting the County assume the cost of two (2) medical examiner investigator pagers at \$10.00 each per month. Board consensus was to allow this request.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to acknowledge the Personnel Report for the hire of Virginia Threlkeld-Larson, part-time RN, Public Health at \$17.25 per hour effective June 6, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with AFLAC representatives regarding product update regarding various policies and employee options.
