

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
AUGUST 1, 2011

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 1, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the minutes of July 25, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Keokuk County Engineer and Assistant Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. IDOT was sent a concept statement regarding the Keota W15 project from Highway 92.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the claim listing dated August 1, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Discussion was held with Cliff Daugherty, Golden Furrow Representative, regarding anhydrous plant to be built on leased land 1½ miles south of North English. Golden Furrow is owned by a group of farmers that aspire to build an anhydrous plant on Tom Voss' property. Unanimous Board consensus was no objection to placement or building of the anhydrous plant.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the Network Installation and Maintenance Agreement with STI as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended Pathfinders, SIRG and a RUSS meeting in Harper. Hadley attended SEIDA and Area 15 meetings. Berg had no meetings to attend last week.

Met with Renee Von Bokern, labor relations consultant, regarding preliminary union negotiations.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Keith Blair, Veterans' Affairs Director is back in the Courthouse.

On vote and motion the meeting adjourned at 10:20 a.m.
