

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
AUGUST 15, 2011

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 15, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Hadley and Wood were present. Berg was absent.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with District Associate Judge to discuss carpet and maintenance issues in the Magistrate Courtroom and Judges' chambers. Formal action will be held on August 22, 2011.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve meth lab clean up cost funding to Summit Environmental Inc. and to authorize Daryl Wood to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer and Assistant Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Matters discussed were mapped contract rock designated routes and bridge inspection results.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of August 8, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended Pathfinders and 10-15 Transit meetings. Hadley had no meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Board received a letter complimenting the Conservation Director and staff on how well Belva Deer Park is maintained. Blair, Veterans' Affairs Director, informed the Board he will receive \$10,000 in Veterans' Affairs grant funding.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the claim listing dated August 15, 2011 with the deduction of an Emergency Management claim for \$5.68 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Keokuk County Courthouse Electrical Project update was held. The majority of second floor will be completed this week with projections to move to first floor the following week. Miscellaneous matters will be finished up in September that will conclude the project.

On vote and motion the meeting adjourned at 11:35 a.m.
