The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, September 6, 2011 in the Drafting Room of the Courthouse. The meeting location was moved due to the electricians working in the Board Room. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the minutes of August 29, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Assistant Keokuk County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Contract rock hauling started today (6th). The annual Secondary Roads Safety Meeting will be held October 27, 2011.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the claim listing dated September 6, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the proclamation for Constitution Week (September 17, 2011 through September 23, 2011) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to set the public hearing regarding Keokuk County Voting Precinct Boundary Ordinance No. 39 for Monday, September 19, 2011 at 9:30 a.m., Board Room, First Floor, Keokuk County Courthouse. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with CPC/General Assistance regarding monthly Community Services update.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a Pathfinders meeting. Berg attended an Empowerment meeting. Hadley had no meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. ISAC Fall School is November 16-18, 2011 in Coralville, Iowa. ICAP recommendations regarding loss control efforts were reviewed. Assessor Richmond informed the Board he printed off updated maps for the City of What Cheer.

Keokuk County Courthouse Electrical Project update was held. All office work will be completed by the end of September with work continuing into October to install the fire system.
