The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, October 3, 2011 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the tentative agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of September 26, 2011. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Assistant Keokuk County Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Outstanding inquires were discussed. Contract rock continues to be hauled on designated routes.

Hadley moved, Wood seconded to approve the contract with Hawkeye Paving Corp. for Project PP-2012(1)-54 Fall 2011 Pavement Patching as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the claim listing dated October 3, 2011 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the proclamation proclaiming October 2nd thru October 7th, 2011 as 4-H week. All ayes and motion carried.

Consideration and possible approval of purchase of carpet for Public Health Office was held. Board consensus was to gather bids and present for formal action at a later date.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve certification of expenses for September 13, 2011 Keokuk County School Elections as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS and Pathfinders meetings. Hadley attended Sieda and Area 15 meetings. Berg's meeting was cancelled therefore having no meetings to attend last week

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Data/phone swap over issues were discussed. County contribution towards the Keokuk County advertisement in the Central Iowa Travel Guide was decided by Board consensus in the amount of \$400.
